

Urgent Care

The concept of urgent care for your pet is very similar to the human urgent care model. We will be there for a problem or condition that should be seen the same day, but it is not necessarily an emergency.

Symptoms that would constitute an urgent care appointment:

- Vomiting
- Coughing
- Diarrhea
- Ocular discharge
- Ear infections
- Abnormal behavior
- Limping

Emergencies

We will provide emergency care any time of the day. If your pet normally sees another veterinarian, and receives urgent or emergency care from us, we will provide detailed records for your veterinarian.

Some things that would constitute an emergency visit:

- Trauma
- Respiratory Distress
- Snake Bites
- Eye Emergencies
- Bleeding
- Vomiting / Diarrhea
